Donating blood is essential for saving lives and it also offers an array of physical and mental health benefits to the donor. According to National Blood Transfusion Council, any healthy adult, both male and female, can donate blood. Men can donate safely once in every three months while women can donate every four months.

Blood and blood products are important for effective management of women suffering from bleeding associated with pregnancy and childbirth; children suffering from severe anaemia due to malaria and malnutrition; patients with blood and bone marrow disorders, inherited disorders of haemoglobin and immune deficiency conditions; victims of trauma, emergencies, disasters and accidents; as well as patients undergoing advanced medical and surgical procedures. The need for blood is universal, but access to blood for all those who need it is not. Blood shortages are particularly acute in low- and middle-income countries," according to World Health Organization.

World Blood Donor Day Theme : The World Blood Donor Day slogan for the year 2022 is "Donating blood is an act of solidarity. Join the effort and save lives" in order to draw attention to the roles that voluntary blood donations play in saving lives and enhancing solidarity within communities.

World Blood Donor Day was established in 2004 by the World Health Organization (WHO) to bring awareness to the ongoing need for blood donations to save lives. June 14 also marks the birth anniversary of Karl Landsteiner who won the Nobel Prize for Medicine in 1930 for his work in classifying blood types. It was his work that revolutionised blood transfusions and led to the practice of transfusing blood between people with compatible blood types.

## SECONDARY METABOLITES AND PLANT-FUNGI INTERACTION

Secondary metabolites are the small organic molecules that are not involved in the normal growth and development of an organic but are the language of communication as well as the defense weapons of the plants. These are classified into major groups as terpenoids, alkaloids and phenolic compounds. Plants produce diverse array of secondary metabolites in their cells for fitness, attracting insects, communication and signaling. These secondary metabolites are not only meant for plants requirements but also beneficiary for human life.

Secondary metabolites play vital role in our life. Rauwolfia serpentine is a safe and effective treatment for hypertension. Cissus quadrangularis is useful in diabetes, bone fractures, cancers, weak bones and also as body building supplements. Cintella asiatica is well known for it's anti-oxidant activity. It is used as food. Elephantopus scaberis known for its antimicrobial, antitumor, antidiarrheal and antidiabetic activity. Cinchona tree bark consists of quinine and best known for its antimalarial property. Vincristine isolated from the leaves of Vinca rosea is best known for anticancer property.

Fungi interaction with plants can result in few diseases. But the diseases resulted by plant-fungi interaction is useful in the production of secondary metabolites. This is really astonishing! Yes, limited severity of disease in the plant can induce the formation of the new compound. Limited rate of disease can increase the rate of formation of the secondary metabolites and hence the amount of metabolites increases and origin of new compound is also takes place.

According to HPLTC method of alnalysis, the amount of secondary metabolites is more in infected plant than in healthy plant and origin of the new compound takes place on disease severity. Generally, we all have a concept that diseas is the severe trouble to the plants. But in some specific conditions like plant-fungi interactions, the disease itself aids the plants to produce some secondary metabolites which is very useful to plant and mankind.


## MATHEMATICS IN VIDEO GAMES

Maths is everything when it comes to games. According to game designing organization, mathematics is the absolute fundamental foundation of every successful game and necessary for everything to work as the designer intends. Maths doesn't work unless you learn and apply the rules; a video game can't have rules without Mathematics.

Algebra, Discrete Mathematics, Trigonometry, calculus and Linear algebra are the main branches of maths. They are also used in arts side of the game development. Several mathematical principles work behind the creation of computer games like Geometry, Matrices, Vectors, Transformations etc. Most of the video games take place in a 3D virtual world. In that, objects and characters are created by 3D points. The one who makes a program uses maths to create characters. Moreover, without maths programmers would not be able to make objects in game softwares.

The use of Geometry in video games is that they use geometric shapes which is congruent with other shapes. They use geometric shapes by rotating, reflecting and by the use of similarities in making the video graphics to move around the screen during action sequences. Some of the video games are PUBG, Angry bird, free fire, Wow and Pokemon etc. In particular, the game PUBG we have to use geometry like turnings or rotation and also calculate the speed of the weapons and also the direction in which they hit. In a game development, Vector is one of the quantities. It is used to represent Geometric properties of objects like position and direction of the motion within the game world. Game theory can be described as the mathematical study of decision making of Strategy in social situations. It helps to explain how we interact in key decision making process.

## SHRI B.S. YEDDYURAPPA

Bookanakere Siddalingappa Yediyurappa (born 27 February 1943), often referred to by his initials BSY, is an Indian politician currently serving as the member of the Bharatiya Janata Party. He served as the 19th Chief Minister of Karnataka, and currently a Member of the Karnataka Legislative Assembly. He is also the only politician so far in Karnataka to have served four times as Chief Minister and three times as Leader of the Opposition in the Karnataka Legislative Assembly. He is the longest serving Chief Minister of Karnataka from BJP. He is a MLA from Shikaripura constituency in Shimoga district, from where he has been elected eight times.


In 2008, Yediyurappa became the chief minister after leading BJP to a victory in the Karnataka Assembly elections, for the first time in a South Indian state. Having been associated with the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh from his college days, Yediyurappa's public service began when he was appointed as Karyavaha (Secretary) of the Sangh's Shikaripur unit in 1970. In 1972, he was elected to the Shikaripura Town Municipality and was also appointed as the President of the Taluk unit of the Jana Sangh. He was imprisoned during the Emergency in India and lodged in the Bellary and Shimoga jails. In 1980, he was appointed President of the Shikaripura taluk unit of the BJP and later went on to become the president of Shimoga district BJP unit in 1985. In 1988, he became the State President of the BJP. He was first elected to the lower house of the Karnataka Legislature in 1983 and has since represented the Shikaripura constituency six times. He has been a member of the Seventh, Eighth, Ninth, Tenth, Twelfth and Thirteenth Legislative Assemblies of Karnataka. Following the 1994 state assembly elections, he became the Leader of Opposition in the Karnataka Legislative Assembly. In 1999, he lost the elections but was nominated by the BJP to become a member of the legislative council of Karnataka. Again, he was re-elected in 2004 and became the Leader of Opposition in the Karnataka Legislative Assembly during the chief ministership of Dharam Singh.

In December 2020, the Government of Karnataka, under his leadership passed the Anti CowSlaughter bill 2020, in aim to protect and nurture the cattle in the state that were alleged being slaughtered illegally. The legislation empowered the police to inspect and seize vehicles that transport cattle and the premises where they are slaughtered. The new law brought stern punishment of imprisonment of up to 3 years and a penalty of 50,000 rupees.

During the Covid pandemic Karnataka became the first state to open a 10,000 bed Covid hospital and care centre in Bangalore. Yediyurappa after a cabinet meet concerning the COVID-19 pandemic announced that the Karnataka government would be providing 1 Lakh aid to BPL families who lost a working person in the first or second wave of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Later on 26 July 2021, he announced his resignation to the post of Chief Minister during his speech in the two years anniversary of his government. He cited the 75 years age-limit rule in BJP. During the speech he went through his memories of 45 years of his political career, thanked his party leaders and high command, and submitted his resignation that afternoon, to the Governor of Karnataka

Mr. Yaddyurappa supports women to overcome of their hurdles by providing the jobs like Garments where women can also work and earn money. Mr. Yaddyurappa has been providing value based education through colleges and schools. He developed the Shikaripura taluk in every aspect, every village got road, home facilities, water facilities, and electric facilities. He helped very much to farmers by providing subsidy

But the blossoming of this relatively new technology also raises concerns about its long-term safety to human health and environment.

We can create unique materials and products which are stronger, lighter, cheaper and precise. But as well as nano particles can cause serious illness or damage to human body. Carbon nanotubes could cause infection of lungs. It can also lead to loss of jobs in manufacturing and farming sector and nano pollution will be created by toxic waste.

Nanotechnology is the "corner stone of biotechnology". It is portmanteau of picometer and technology. It is a hypothetical future level of technology manipulation of matter, on the scale of trillianth of a metre of picoscale(10-12). The potential application of picotechnology have been evaluated especially in the deciplines of biomedical and environmental science.

It's extended surface area and improved electrical,chemical,optical and mechanical properties make picotechnological products even better than nanomaterials. It brings the attention of the scientific world towards the picoscale interventions. It is newly emerging technology with applications in numerous sectors. Adequaqte developments in this will certainly change human lives because it will make possible for the research world to dive into systems and structures on picoscale.

It will render a platform through which explores can travel into ultra small areas, which will lead to the creation of new dimensions as well as new opportunities. Eventually in future, the picotechnology will become smaller enough to give birth to another technology in real world applications.

## ANGLO-SAXON ENGLISH LITERATURE

ANGLO-SAXONS: The Anglo-Saxons were migrants from Northern Europe who settled in England in the fifth and sixth centuries. It is celebrated on 12th January every year since 1985 to commemorate the birth anniversary of Swami Vivekananda all over India at schools and colleges, with processions, speeches, music, youth conventions, seminars etc. The Government of India quoted that "the philosophy of Swamiji and the ideals for which he lived and worked could be a great source of inspiration for the Indian Youth Day". Swami Vivekananda, an Indian monk, philosopher, author and religious teacher was born as Narendranath Datta on 12th January, 1863 in Calcutta, Bengal Presidency, British India. His father was Vishwanath Datta and mother was Bhubaneswari Devi. His guru was Ramakrishna Paramahamsa who believed that the different religions of the world are only different ways to reach the same god. His famous works were Sangeet Kalpataru, Karma Yoga, Raja Yoga and many more. He is best known in the United States for his groundbreaking speech starting with the words, "Sisters and Brothers of America....", in the 1893 World's Parliament of Religions held at Chicago, in which he introduced Hinduism to Americans. He died on 4th July, 1902 at the age of 39.

One of the famous quotes of Swami Vivekananda is "Take Risks In Your Life. If You Win, You Can Lead! If You Lose, You Can Guide!"

## NCC ROLE IN SCHOOL

The National Cadet Corps came into existence on 16th July1948 under the NCC Act XXXVI of 1948 under the Ministry of Defense. The Motto of the NCC is 'Unity and Discipline' which was adopted on 23rdDecember1957. In lining up to its motto, the NCC strives to be and is one of the greatest cohesive forces of our nation, bringing together the youth hailing from different parts of our country and molding them into united, secular and disciplined citizens of our nation.

The aims of NCC is to develop character, commandership, discipline, leadership, secular outlook, spirit of adventure, Sportsmanship and ideals of Selfless service among the youth of the country; to create a human resource of organized, trained and motivated youth to provide leadership in all walks of life and always be available for the service of the nation; to provide a suitable environment to motivate the youth to take up a career in the Armed Forces.

NCC in the school plays a credible role in shaping the character of students by instilling the values of patriotism, service, discipline and hard work. Training in NCC insists qualities like nationalism, patriotism, discipline, team spirit Leadership, self-confidence and promote overall personality development. NCC gives a tremendous opportunity to one and all betterment, irrespective of caste, Creed, religion and economic status. Based on the aims of NCC; the organization has laid down training syllabi for cadets. The syllabus for the Junior Division Cadets covers a period of two years. Except for minor the syllabus for each division is similar for boy and girl cadets. The training year matches the Academic and financial year.

The troop NCC of Kumadvathi Residential central school is functioning under the 20 Karnataka Battalion NCC, Shivamogga which authorized the total strength is 100 including JD and JW cadets. The unit has an enrolled strength 100 cadets of which 40 are girls, which includes the Open Quota. The first year includes 30 JD and 20 JW 's, the second years include 30 JD and 20JW's. Each academic year, special attention was taken to celebrate nationally important days such as Republic Day, Independence Day etc. On these days, many of the selected cadets attended the parade at Taluk Headquater Office, shikaripura as a part of International Yoga Day; The NCC cadets had a special Yoga training in the school indoor hall. The proudest achievement of this year was that two of the cadets attended TSC-1 and RDC-1 at Moodbidri, Samarth M Gowda and Bhargav, 22 cadets participated CATC conducted at Shivamogga. 23 Cadets attended the Army Training Camp at Moodbidri. Various activities and classes were conducted among the cadets, students and common people about the COVID 19.
